

1. Every participant must be registered prior to fishing.
2. Persons of any age may enter. If a person under 18 years of age wins a prize, their parent or legal guardian (over 18 years of age) will accept the prize for them.
3. The tournament will begin on September 24, 2011, at 12:00 am.
4. All participants must catch their fish with a rod and reel or pole. No gigging allowed.
5. All fish entered must be caught according to Texas Parks & Wildlife and federal fishing rules and regulations..
6. All entries must be caught from public fishing areas. The Dow Barge Canal is strictly off limits.
7. All entered fish must be caught in Texas Coastal waters or adjacent federal waters.
8. The tournament boundaries will be from the Colorado River to the Galveston Causeway.
9. Fish will be checked for freshness. Fish may be gutted and examined, and undigested fish, however introduced, will be removed.
10. The official weighing station will be located at the Freeport Community House located at 1300 West Second St, Freeport, TX
You must be in line to weigh-in no later than 4:30 pm, No fish will be accepted after that time.
11. You are ineligible to fish in this tournament if you:
 - a. Are a USCG licensed charter captain
 - b. Are a guide or professional or commercial fishermen, or if you carry passengers for hire
12. In case of a tie, the first fish entered will be the winner.
13. Protests will only be accepted in writing before the close of each respective tournament.
14. The drawing for the barbeque pit raffle will be after the awards.
